

Resolution presented by the delegation of

Guinea

Themes Conflicts and international security

Concern Organization of the movement of the population of Africa for the refugees

General Assembly,

Establishing yearly, that approximately 30'000 Sierra Leoneans migrate to guinea

Recognized that it is a common duty of all nations and a matter of respect for the fundamental principles of human rights to take in refugees,

Perplexed that nothing has been done about refugee's flow in Africa and that no system has been put in place,

Alarmed that the stream of refugees doesn't help with the economy of our country,

Aware of how difficult it is to be displaced from their countries due to various reasons; mostly against their will,

Decide how to regulate the flux of incoming refugees from distressed countries ; including the repartition of the refugees into other countries,

Propose to resolve this ongoing issue and discuss possible dispatching solutions to minimize the load of refugees on our country :

1. Create valid jobs for the migrants that stay in the country, hence boosting our economy- integrate them into the society.
2. Provide support to for persons in need of international protection living or a pathway to other welcoming countries abroad.
3. Improve protection, aid migrants and communities and enable the assisted voluntary return of vulnerable and stranded migrants from both Liberia and Sierra Leone .
