

Resolution presented by the delegation of  
Lithuania.

Theme Conflicts and international security

Concerning Threats caused by Cybersecurity and the safety of the population.

General assembly,

**Convinced** that a part of the population of Lithuania feel unsafe of the unawareness of where their data is going,

**Disgraceful** that actions have not been taken sooner,

**Judge** that the crimes caused by lack of cyber security, such as identity theft, financial fraud and stalking are very important and should be much more addressed,

**Shocked** that this critical problem has yet been addressed and taken care of enough

**Historically** we find evidence of cyber-attacks and breaches within every single country. Many are struggling to find ways to reduce to as this is a problem that submerged only a few years ago.

**Propose** to be able to keep the people from Lithuania safe:

- To spread awareness about the dangers that social media and any other forms of media that lacks cybersecurity.
- For the government of Lithuania to be able to access all data from everyone entering the country, into the borders. This would put in place a policy for firms to not access the people's data anymore.
- This would allow the government to see all the internet history, location, messages, calls... of any type of device, whether it be phone, computer, TV, tablet or Bluetooth headphones, if anything were to happen to anyone in the country, the government could find out in less than 2 minutes. This data would only be used if needed for crimes of 3 or above.
- To keep this data safe the population of Lithuania and other who might enter, the UN will vote every 5 years for 15 eligible bachelors for this position, which will again be voted by the Lithuanian population and reduced to 13 people. And from that only 10 will be internally selected by the government to keep this data safe. In case of death or other, we will have the 3 very eligible bachelors.
