

## RESOLUTION XII – FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF SOMALIA

THEME : CONFLICTS AND INTERNATIONAL SECURITY

CONCERN : LANDMINE CLEARANCE IN SOMALIA

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

- Dismayed            to note that Somali soil is littered with anti-personnel mines that are still active to this day, knowing that in 2022, 1,200 Somalis were killed or seriously injured,
- Outraged            to see that an average of four to five people are seriously injured every day by landmines in Somalia,
- Exasperated        to learn that Somali children are forced to make gargantuan detours to get to that farmers are afraid for their livestock and that entire areas have become unusable,
- Noticing            an important uneasiness within people affected by diseases which modern medicine cannot treat and that these same people very often yearn to keep on making themselves useful before their death,
- Decide              to try to solve these two problems with one unique solution :
- to succeed in demining Somalia and other countries that are still concerned by this scourge with the help of volunteer who would wish to do a last honorable gesture ;
  - that chronically ill patients all over the globe who wish to have access to assisted suicide and help humanity during their last days on Earth can now count on "SomaliExit", in collaboration with "Handicap International" which have kindly accepted to fund the necessary material for a mine clearance programme in Somalia aiming to bravely walk through the mine fields, offering to the volunteers an opportunity to gift their life to save many populations on Earth.
