## RESOLUTION XIII – REPUBLIC OF POLAND

THEME: POLITICAL AND SOCIAL RIGHTS

CONCERN: COMBATING LGBTQI+ LOBBIES IN EDUCATION

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

Regretting that many Member States of this assembly, such as the Netherlands, Spain, New Zealand,

and South Africa, aim to promote the inclusion of so-called LGBTQI+ communities by granting them access to educational settings, only to subsequently allow them to

disseminate convictions that are not of a natural order,

Deeply concerned about the influence of ideologies that contradict the fundamental principles of our cultures,

disregarding individuals' right to form their own thoughts, as well as the potential issues our

societies might face, such as the increase in youth suicides,

**Emphasizing** that the LGBTQI+ community is deeply committed to promoting its convictions by intruding

and imposing its ideas in an intrusive manner, even though they are contrary to our cultures,

religions, and the general well-being of our institutions,

Commending Hungary, Turkey, Saudi Arabia, Egypt, Iraq, and many other countries rich in strong values

and convictions, as well as all nations that proudly defend their cultural heritages and

deepest principles, refusing to succumb to the current irrational trend,

**Decides** to establish an international assessment system aimed at testing the neutrality of individuals

supporting LGBTQI+ lobbies to ensure that their work as education officials is completely impartial,

to prohibit the development of courses related to sexual orientation and gender identity in the field of education to align with Article 17 of the International Convention on the Rights of

the Child, in order to protect children from harmful information,

to prohibit pro-LGBTQI+ audiovisual propaganda in the sphere of education, in order to

create an environment conducive to learning.
