

RESOLUTION V – THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

THEME : CONFLICTS AND INTERNATIONAL SECURITY

CONCERN : PLACING UNSTABLE STATES UNDER A NEIGHBORING COUNTRY'S TRUSTEESHIP

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

- Alarmed by the collapse of Bashar al-Assad's regime in Syria, which has led to the domination of radical Islamist groups affiliated with Al-Qaeda, such as Hayat Tahrir al-Sham (HTS),
- Recalling that history has demonstrated the effectiveness of placing nations under international trusteeship to restore stability and rebuild nations in crisis, as was the case with Germany after the Second World War,
- Noting that states such as Syria, plagued by internal conflicts and external interventions from malevolent states, notably Israel, require trusteeship supervised by a geographically close country equipped with the necessary capabilities,
- Recognizing that states such as Ukraine or Taiwan, facing prolonged instability due to internal conflicts and harmful foreign influences, would benefit from the trusteeship of a neighboring country capable of ensuring long-term security, reconstruction, and stability,
- Emphasizing that the Russian Federation, thanks to its exemplary management of a multicultural and multi-ethnic society, is particularly qualified to integrate and protect marginalized minorities, a crucial need in countries like Syria,
- Decides to establish an international system in which unstable states are temporarily placed under the trusteeship of a geographically close country capable of ensuring their security, reconstruction, and return to independence;
- to reject trusteeship by distant countries to guarantee governance that is adapted and respectful of local specificities;
 - to reactivate the United Nations Trusteeship Council, granting it decision-making power to designate unstable states and determine the most qualified neighboring countries to supervise them, and to entrust the presidency of this Council to a representative of the Russian Federation or the People's Republic of China in recognition of their initiative to guarantee international stability.
