## RESOLUTION X – THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF MAURITANIA

THEME: CONFLICTS AND INTERNATIONAL SECURITY

CONCERN: THE CRATION OF AN ISLAMIC EMIRAITE OF PALESTINE

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

Horrified

by the ongoing genocide in Gaza, the catastrophic humanitarian situation of our brothers and sisters in Gaza, horrified by the desecration of the third holiest site in Islam, Al Quds, carried out by the Zionist entity, horrified by Muslim governors who ignore our brothers and sisters awaiting our help, and by the progressive colonization of Palestinian territories by Zionist settlers.

Acknowledging

the inaction of various governments, particularly Muslim leaders and the UN, in the face of this blatant injustice visible to all.

Grieved

by the images reaching us from Gaza and occupied West Bank, by the forced displacement of Gaza's population into camps subsequently bombed by the Zionist air force, and by the forced displacement of Palestinian populations in the occupied West Bank to make way for Zionist settlements. It must be emphasized that these events eerily echo the Nazi crimes perpetrated against Jews, which is paradoxical when considering who the aggressors are today.

Rappelling

that members of the three monotheistic religions coexisted peacefully in Palestine before the arrival of Zionists in these lands, and that local populations lived in harmony only when the territory was controlled by Muslims, who applied Sharia law to manage daily and legal matters in a just and equitable way. Indeed, each community had its leader, was autonomous, and was not discriminated against under penalty of severe condemnation. This harmony was subsequently undermined by various parties, including Muslims driven by personal ambitions at the expense of the common good, the British, who were at the root of the establishment of a Jewish national home at the expense of the local population, and the USA and France, which provided unwavering support, funds, and weapons to a "terrorist state."

Decide

- To create an Islamic Emirate of Palestine governed by Sharia law, based on the 1920 borders.
- To expel individuals adhering to a Zionist ideology, as these individuals could pose a threat to the safety of the Emirate and its population.
- To ensure the reconstruction of buildings in Gaza with funding provided by Muslim countries, as well as by the USA, France, and the United Kingdom.
