RESOLUTION I - THE INDEPENDENT STATE OF SAMOA

THEME: POLITICAL AND SOCIAL RIGHTS

CONCERN: THE RECEPTION AND PROTECTION OF REFUGEES

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

Recalling that exil is never a choice, but a necessity to flee conflicts or climatic danger,

Outraged that over the last decade, 63 000 people have disappeard or died trying to flee

their countries with a significant increase in 2023,

Alarmed that funding for the High Commission for Refugees will only reach 45% of its

needs by 2024,

Denouncing the difference in treatment between asylum seekers from continents such as

Africa and those from Europe,

Decides to set up an international emergency rescue service at sea to deal with the risk

of drowning;

to ease asylum application conditions for people from former colonies ans

migrating to old colonial countries;

that United Nations members should contribute 3% of PIB to HCR, whether

solely financially or by receiving asylum seekers under dignified conditions.
