

## RESOLUTION I – THE INDEPENDENT STATE OF SAMOA

THEME : POLITICAL AND SOCIAL RIGHTS

CONCERN : THE RECEPTION AND PROTECTION OF REFUGEES

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

- Recalling that exile is never a choice, but a necessity to flee conflicts or climatic danger,
- Outraged that over the last decade, 63 000 people have disappeared or died trying to flee their countries with a significant increase in 2023,
- Alarmed that funding for the High Commission for Refugees will only reach 45% of its needs by 2024,
- Denouncing the difference in treatment between asylum seekers from continents such as Africa and those from Europe,
- Decides to set up an international emergency rescue service at sea to deal with the risk of drowning ;
- to ease asylum application conditions for people from former colonies and migrating to old colonial countries ;
  - that United Nations members should contribute 3% of PIB to HCR, whether solely financially or by receiving asylum seekers under dignified conditions.
