

RESOLUTION IV – DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

THEME : POLITICAL AND SOCIAL RIGHTS

CONCERN : A TRANSITION TOWARDS DEMOCRATIA, AN IDEAL TECHNOCRACY

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

Deplores	growing corruption and thirst for power of some authoritarian regimes, but also of democratic regimes, as Mme Satterthwaite well says: « the governments who attained power by legitimate elections then exercise their power in order to undermine systems and democratic rights »,
Worried	by the 2024 report from Transparency International NGO which reveals that 148 countries have seen their corruption level stagnate or worsen since 2012, as well as by the IGO International IDEA which reports that 94 countries have been demoted on at least one democratic indicator,
Alarmed	by the fact that more than a third of the global population lives in an authoritarian regime, and that only 32 countries have improved their democracy index score in 2023, according to a study of The Economist Intelligence Unit,
Notices	that the malfunction of current governments greatly influences the states' stability,
Congratulates	Albania who is already on the road to success with the implementation of Diella, their new minister of Public Markets, designed using an algorithm created to promote transparency,
Thinks	of the future and general well-being of the citizens of the world who will witness a decrease of social inequalities and therefore, their quality of life improve,
Decides	<p>to establish a presidential Artificial Intelligence, democratIA, who will be responsible of governing states, thereby removing the moral responsibility of politicians ;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- that each country be responsible of its own programme such that we take into account its personal challenges, all while respecting a well-defined charter of the UNO which will have as a goal to counter all abuses ;- the creation of an organ attached to the UNO containing one deputy per country who will have to assist to the annual General Assemblies, in order to discuss the potential misuses, but also potential improvements with the aim to favour mutual assistance.
