

RESOLUTION VII – MORROCCO

THEME : POLITICAL AND SOCIAL RIGHTS

CONCERN : THE EVACUATION AND RELOCATION OF PERSECUTED LGBT POPULATIONS

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

Noting an increase in homophobia in the world, thereby creating numerous tensions and persecutions in the countries where LGBT populations reside,

Observing the many anti-LGBT acts growing around the world, such as the Orlando shooting in 2016 which caused the death of 49 people and injured 53 people, or the Oslo attack in 2022 which caused around twenty injuries and 2 deaths, thus creating a climate of insecurity for everyone,

Remarking that approximately half of the countries in Africa and others in many regions of the world make LGBT ideology an illegal act punishable by law, such as many years of imprisonment in Algeria and Burkina Faso, or even the death penalty in Brunei, thereby monopolizing the already weak judicial system in these countries,

Emphasizing that many countries remain a Muslim state deeply rooted in its values and therefore do not protect these populations,

Compelled to note that the customs and values of many countries are not in alignment with the values promoted by the LGBT community, which thus creates a danger for the cohesion of the countries,

Recalling the impact that colonization has had not only on Morocco but also on African, South American, and Asian countries, and fearing any form of imposition of external values or social models,

Decides to commit to offering LGBT populations a viable and sustainable solution, thereby giving them a chance to live with dignity outside the countries threatening them;

- to greatly facilitate the departure of these persons living in territories where their presence causes a problem, toward host countries ;
- the creation of a framework for multilateral cooperation, including transfer agreements, reception and integration programs, as well as monitoring mechanisms guaranteeing the protection and well-being of the persons concerned ;
- to support and finance UNHCR in order to allow it to further focus its actions on the protection and assistance of LGBT persons in situations of vulnerability ;
- to encourage the establishment of confidential procedures carried out by trained personnel to accurately identify persecuted LGBT persons and prevent any abuse by people pretending to be LGBT.
