

RESOLUTION XV – CZECH REPUBLIC

THEME : CONFLICTS AND INTERNATIONAL SECURITY

CONCERN : THE ESTABLISHMENT OF INTERNATIONAL TRUSTEESHIP OVER COUNTRIES UNDER AN AUTHORITARIAN SYSTEM

THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

Outraged by the international normalization of authoritarian and dictatorial regimes,

Noting that certain powers such as the United States and the Russian Federation allow themselves to intervene directly or indirectly in the internal affairs of foreign countries,

Emphasizing that other States such as the People's Republic of China and North Korea exercise strict and dominant control over their populations, notably through mass surveillance, information censorship, and the systematic repression of all political opposition,

Alarmed by governments refusing to acknowledge the existence of such parasitic regimes in these countries,

Accusing certain major military powers of deliberately maintaining global instability in order to preserve their political, military, and economic influence,

Concerned by the complicit silence of the international community in the face of massive violations of human rights and international law, including arbitrary arrests, restrictions on fundamental freedoms, and institutionalized violence, as recently carried out by Donald Trump in Venezuela, or Putin in Ukraine,

Decides to authorize the placement under international trusteeship of authoritarian States guilty of repeated violations of human rights ;

- to revoke the right of veto from States abusing this privilege to protect dictatorial regimes ;
- to officially recognize the United States, the Russian Federation, the People's Republic of China, Iran, Cameroon, Belarus, Syria, and Turkmenistan as States with authoritarian governments.
